Prepare:

5–6 interesting questions

Note down their answers or key points.

3. Be a Storyteller (Comic Strip Activity)

Collect or draw 4–6 pictures for a comic strip.

Pictures can be from newspapers, magazines, or hand-drawn

Arrange them in order to create a simple story

Tip: Choose easy ideas like:

Helping a friend

Losing and finding something

A funny incident

Kindness to animals

In Class:

Students will turn their pictures into a comic strip:

Add speech bubbles

Write 1–2 simple sentences in each box

Give a title

(Optional) Add a moral
